

Dear Sir or Madam,

Keith Howard, Sunnyside United Neighbors, asked that I forward the attached information regarding the process and criteria for identifying a site for a commuter rail maintenance facility that could serve the US36 and I70 corridors. A map of candidate sites is included. One of these sites is proximate to Sunnyside, Highlands, and Chaffee Park. Transit maintenance facilities are required for the storage, maintenance, and upkeep of transit vehicles and typically include an area for vehicle and supply storage, a maintenance shop(s), offices, and employee parking.

Come and learn about this type of facility and provide your input to representatives of the Regional Transportation District, the Colorado Department of Transportation, and the US 36 Project Team.

I look forward to sharing more information with you about the US 36 Environmental Impact Statement and the potential maintenance facility at the next Sunnyside United Neighbors meeting on February 9.
